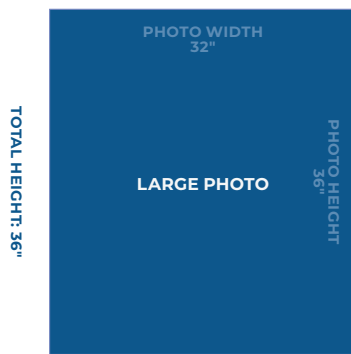

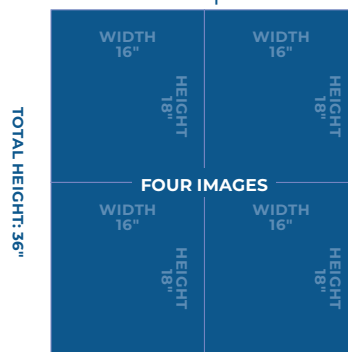

**OPTION 1:** One large image sized at 32" w x 36" h at 300dpi

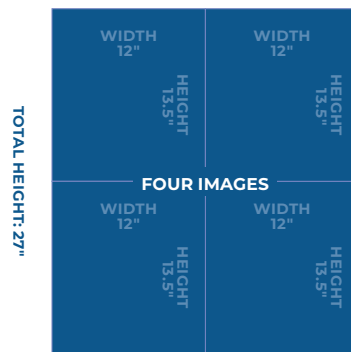


TOTAL WIDTH: 32"
